

Volunteer Tuberculosis Risk Assessment

(Mandatory)

Volunteers in the Head Start classroom are required to provide a Tuberculosis/TB Risk Assessment clearance within seven days of initial date of volunteer status (CHDP Guidelines for Child Care Centers/Title 22). Tuberculosis Risk Assessment CF/H-13d is used by CFS nurses and parents to review Tuberculosis risk factors.

Health staff and volunteers complete CF/H-13d questions 1 – 6. Volunteer signs and dates. Nurse reviews form for TB risk factors. Nurse signs, dates, and indicates if PPD is needed by checking either Yes or No box. If yes is checked, Date of Referral is indicated.

Health staff will place in volunteer binder file and document in electronic file system.
