CA Immunization Registry Refusal/Information Request / CA Immunization Registry Disclosure Statement Forms

The CA Immunization Refusal/Information Request Form and the CA Immunization Registry Disclosure Statement Forms are to be given to parent/guardian concurrently.

The California Immunization Registry (formerly known as RIDE) is a state-wide data base that permits the sharing of computer records of a child's immunization records, no matter where they are given. It allows healthcare providers to view the child's immunization records to determine if the child is up to date and if not, what shots need to be given. The information is confidential.

Head Start is committed to partnering with the Immunization Registry and health staff will update immunization of children enrolled in Head Start as immunization information becomes available. Head Start staff can utilize the service to access previous immunization records to ensure a child's immunizations are up to date, per Head Start guidelines.

The parent/guardian at time of enrollment will be given the Immunization Registry Disclosure Statement that explains the benefits of the program, along with the CA Immunization Registry Refusal/Information Request Form.

The CA Immunization Registry Refusal/Information Request Form allows the parent/guardian to refuse this service or to request additional information. If the parent/guardian wishes for any of the above, the FSW or Health Staff will complete the form with the parent/guardian and document their wishes. The form will then be faxed to the CA Immunization Registry at (209) 558-7511. The refusal form will then be placed in child's health file with documentation as needed.
