

On-Site Dental Examination Result Form

Head Start may arrange for facility visits by a licensed dentist to complete dental exams as needed. The On-Site Dental Examination Results form is completed by the dentist providing the exams at the facility and given to the designated staff after completion in order to communicate to the parent/guardian that the child was examined and any follow up treatment is needed. The form also indicates if fluoride varnish was applied at the time of the exam.

Once the health staff receives the completed form, it is distributed as follows:

White: given to parent/guardian

Yellow: filed in child's health file

If dental follow up is recommended by the dentist, the designated staff will work with the child's parent/guardian to complete follow up dental treatment as needed.
