Infant/Toddler Program Extension

Title 22 regulations permit infants/toddlers whose developmental needs require continuation in an infant/toddler center to remain in the center up to a maximum age of 36 months (101361 {a}).

- 1. Parents complete the form by filling in their name and that of their child's.
- 2. Developmental Needs: The infant/toddler's primary caregiver, in conjunction with the parent, determine and indicate the child's developmental needs next to the listed developmental domain(s) that apply: Cognitive, Social Emotional, Physical Motor and/or Language.
- 3. Parent/Guardian signs and dates the form.
- 4. Designated staff signs and dates the form.
- 5. This form should be placed in the Child's file.

**This extension request must be used as intended by State Licensing for children, who for legitimate developmental reasons, should remain in their respective child care programs. Programs must maintain developmental screening and assessment data that supports the requested child care extension.
