- 2. Teachers/Site Supervisors/Nurses/Disabilities Supervisors/Family Service Workers provide assistance to families in getting needed services through Child Study Team Meetings, Individualized Education Program (IEP), Individualized Family Service Plans (IFSP) and Family Portfolios.
