Policy: SCOE will ensure that when providing transportation services, training for

parents and children in pedestrian safety will be provided.

Procedure:

1. Grantee staff will review records annually to ensure the following information has been given to the children in a training session within 30 days of enrollment:

- a. Safe riding practices
- b. Safety procedures for boarding and leaving the vehicle
- c. Safety procedures in crossing the street at stops
- d. Recognition of the danger zones around the vehicle
- e. Practice in emergency-evacuation procedures conducted on the vehicle
- 2. Grantee staff will review records annually to ensure the following information has been given to the parents of children being transported, in a training session:
 - a. The importance of escorting children to the vehicle stop
 - b. The importance of reinforcing the training provided to the children regarding vehicle safety
- 3. Grantee staff will review records two times per program year to ensure that at least two bus evacuation drills in addition to the original required evacuation drill have taken place.
- 4. Grantee staff will review classroom activity plans on an ongoing basis to ensure ageappropriate activities reminding children of the safety procedures take place on a regular basis.
